You gave Karima a second chance

Just over a decade ago, Karima – a child at the time – and her mother arrived in Ottawa, new to Canada entirely. Their new surroundings challenged them to adapt, and it led them to their own challenges within their relationship. By the time Karima had reached adolescence, she found herself in constant conflict with her mother. "Constant fights made me feel like I didn't want to come home."

As conflict continued to escalate with her mother, Karima was forced to leave home. She spent three long years sleeping on friends' couches, desperately trying to finish high school – her main priority. Finally, a concerned school counsellor suggested she contact YSB.

She was afraid, but because of the help from people like you, YSB was able to intervene and help at a most crucial time in her life. Karima came to YSB's Young Women's Emergency Shelter. For the first time in years, she had her own room. As her trust of YSB staff grew, she learned of a range of support services that could help her secure meaningful work, find long-term housing, complete her education, and much more.

"At YSB, I got the support that I needed. If they couldn't help me, they could direct me to someone who could... They've been my family."

Karima moved to YSB's Long-term Housing, where she could live safely and independently in her own apartment.

"Mentally and physically it has helped me to do a lot. It has helped me to grow. YSB has helped me secure affordable housing. There is an understanding at YSB. People are always given a chance."

Today, Karima happily lives alone in her own apartment, enjoys her full-time job, and in her free time, advocates for affordable housing options for homeless youth. **She's an example of what is possible, when people like YOU spread help and hope**. Karima's life has been profoundly changed by the pathway she's been able to take in life. YOU made it possible.

YSB's new Supportive Housing Hub

Addressing youth homelessness must begin with shelter. It is impossible to address the other factors a young person may be experiencing if they do not have immediate and safe shelter. Unfortunately, there is a stark lack of affordable housing in Ottawa – especially for young people. That means that escaping youth homelessness is even more difficult when there is a shortage of accessible housing. With help from incredible donors like yourself, YSB remains dedicated to ending the cycle of chronic homelessness, and is taking action.

With support from community members like you, alongside the City of Ottawa, **YSB** is honoured to announce a new Supportive Housing Hub for some of Ottawa's



most vulnerable youth. In spring 2018, YSB began construction of a new 39 apartment residence that will offer safe and affordable housing to some of Ottawa's most vulnerable youth. Coupled with affordable housing options, the residence will also offer critical services – such as education support, employment support, counselling, and more – that are proven to help youth break the cycle of chronic homelessness for good. Your dollars at work: Helping more youth through Innovation

In 2017, YSB proudly introduced a new service delivery model to be able to minimize wait times for youth accessing mental health programming, and to better serve them when they come through our doors. The Choice and Partnership Approach (CAPA) means YSB youth workers are directly working in collaboration with youth to determine

their specific goals, so we can better connect them with the services they require to meet their needs, and do so much faster. Thanks to your support and the implementation of CAPA, youth are experiencing shorter wait times to access services, and are at the centre of their own care.
