## Nicole's story "YSB was part of the village that kept her alive."

Five years ago, Mary's oldest daughter, Nicole, was in the midst of battling severe depression and suicidal thoughts. It was an extremely challenging and unstable time for their entire family. Searching for help, Mary was able to find a supportive youth group that brought together young people who shared some of Nicole's common interests and could relate to her experiences. That youth group was found at YSB's downtown Drop-In Centre, and it helped change Nicole's life.

"It's so good that Nicole had her own connections within places like YSB — and aside from family — because the staff and youth group members had a better understanding of what she's going through and have seen it before." says Mary, recalling this time in her daughter's life with compassion. "To have YSB there for her was huge. I knew that Nicole had options with YSB. And she had access to other services too, like employment and education."

Having supportive peers, combined with caring youth workers and counsellors who offer help at the right times, can change everything for a young person who is struggling. Your generosity ensures vulnerable youth like Nicole have supportive spaces to turn to when they are facing some of the most challenging times.

#### YSB's new Youth Housing Hub is underway!

Thanks to the City of Ottawa and incredible partners and donors like you who believe in the resiliency of young people, the construction of YSB's new Youth Housing Hub is underway, and will soon be home to once-homeless and at-risk youth in our community. The 39-unit apartment residence will provide more than just affordable housing, and will also offer crucial support services in the areas of mental health counselling, education, health care, employment, and more.

There has never been a more urgent need for supportive housing for homeless youth in Ottawa.



YSB is proud to announce that \$7 million of the project's \$9 million budget has been secured to-date. Our focus in the coming months is to partner with 39 Founding Families to each contribute \$25,000 to fund a room for youth in the building. This generous gift can be paid over a 5-year period. ### Students in Ottawa gave homeless young women a home...THIS is Youth for Youth



At the end of the 2017/18 school year, the students and community at Joan of Arc Academy celebrated their achievement of raising enough funds to sponsor a room at YSB's Young Women's Emergency Shelter. Their efforts have ensured that homeless young women have a safe and caring place to call home when they otherwise have nowhere else to turn. For one year, a plaque on the door of Room 208 proudly displays the Joan of Arc Academy name.

The Joan of Arc students went above and beyond to reach their goal. They held fundraisers throughout the school year, donated out of pocket, and decided as a group to give up their planned graduation party to be able to sponsor the room. Thanks to their generosity, the young women who will reside in their room this year have more than just immediate, safe shelter. They have access to additional resources offered by YSB – including mental health support, employment, education support, and beyond. Safe housing, coupled with these supports, can mean a newfound sense of hope and a life transformed.

"I am so proud of my students, who care so deeply for the well-being of homeless and at-risk young women." says Teacher Connie Springfield. "They led this project, and it will make a real difference."
